Wild Wonder Camp is an online eco-faith partnership project between Camp Awesome (United Church of Canada), Greening Sacred Spaces, Country Fun Nature Camp (Tucker House), with support from CanaDiana UnlimiTed environmental educators. The program uses the Zoom platform, with a minimum of two screened and trained camp counsellors leading activity sessions for ages 5-12. The camp will provide inclusive faith-based learning using stories and lessons from the Bible, and environmental education themes on understanding, appreciation, and exploring nature as part of God's good Creation. There will be outdoor challenges and experiments, guest presenters, and traditional camp activities (online!)
