Bells Corners United Church is seeking one summer student to fill the position of Christian Education Program Assistant, beginning as soon as possible with responsibility to work under general direction at the church until September 2, 2022.

The successful candidate will be

- 1. between the ages of fifteen (15) and thirty (30) years of age,
- 2. preferably, a resident of the Federal Riding of Nepean.
- 3. a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the /Immigration and Refugee Protection Act and;
- 4. legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation and regulations.

Preferred applicants will

- 1. Be a practicing, nascent or journeying Christian, preferably one who is familiar with the beliefs of the United Church of Canada.
- 2. Have a basic understanding of the Bible and the ability to interact with children ranging from four years to 12 years old in a multi-age and virtual setting.
- 3. have experience with Computer Science, with emphasis on PowerPoint creations.
- 4. Experience with live streaming video and video editing will be considered an asset.
- **5.** possess an understand of computers, word processing, software updating

Skills Required:

- 1- Be organized, oriented to program planning, have a working knowledge of the MSOffice suite of applications, particularly PowerPoint, Word, and Excel,
- 2- be able to communicate through a virtual medium such as ZOOM.

- 3- Be a self starter with the ability to work under general direction and often alone,
- 4- Be able to manage time well and meet deadlines, and
- 5- have good oral and written communication skills.

The work entails assisting the ministry team with summer Christian Education resources; assisting with live stream video support during Sunday Worship; creating and producing PowerPoint slides of hymns for the BCUC lyric bank and filling in for the administrative staff while they are absent. The work will be performed at the Bells Corners United Church location or as necessary at home, depending on Pandemic restrictions. The successful candidate will observe safe distancing and health protocols, including the wearing of a suitable mask when others are on site. Several specific projects are also being developed.

The work entails a five-day work week of 7 hours per-day, including Sunday mornings as arranged weekly with the supervisor. Remuneration is at the hourly rate of \$15.00 per hour and is paid monthly.

We are a group of volunteers who are helping the Afghans who helped our Canadian Forces Ottawa and many are currently looking for housing as they have now received their Canadian documents.

They have begun settling the Afghan refugees and some of the families are large. I think they are moving 10 families out of the temporary housing this week. Here is the wish list: Please note we are not asking or accepting clothes and are only providing furniture to the families We also ask items be washed, clean and not torn.

1. Everything Kitchen (pots, pans, cutlery, toasters, microwaves, spatulas, dishes, glasses, mugs etc) Kettles for boiling water is a big thing.

2. Beds - Mattresses and **Box springs** - singles, bunkbeds, double and queen size (singles are in huge demand as the families are quite large) cribs. We are not accepting king size beds at the moment.

- 3. Bedding sheets, blankets, pillows, pillowslips
- 4. Dressers -
- 5. Sofas and living room chairs
- 6. Dining Table and chairs
- 7. Lamps
- 8. Desks (not large ones please)

In short - just about everything but clothes and king size mattresses. Drop off is across from St. Elias Greek Orthodox on Ridgewood Avenue. Warehouse is not always open so it would be best to contact me to arrange drop-off time.
