Amidst the hateful divisive language in today’s conflict-riddled world, real interreligious dialogue is essential. Adherents of all religions should respect and learn from each other in the interests of finding peace and development through mutual enrichment. Our guide on this timely topic is the Canadian scholar Fr. Louis Roy, a Dominican with a doctorate from Cambridge University. Dialogue between Christianity and Buddhism is one of his numerous areas of scholarship and teaching. He will talk about the sources of interreligious dialogue in Christianity; the focus on it since Vatican II; how Catholics can cultivate this dialogue; the pitfalls to avoid and will conclude with some practical guidelines.
