Quarterly Financial Report to BCUC Congregation Quarter ending March 31, 2023

As this is the end of the first quarter, the target numbers are at 25%. Thanks to the continued generosity of members of the church total revenue to the end of March was \$91,967 which represents 19% of budgeted revenue, slightly off

target. Envelope givings are at 18% of projected, the same as last year, PAR givings sit at 24%. Rental income projection has been readjusted upward taking into consideration last years number, the revenue is doing well at 23%. Income does not include the Garage Sale which will be included in the next quarterly report.

The continued endeavour of committees to keep expenses at a minimum led to total expenses at 23% of target, so we are holding the line on our expenses as was the case last year. We continue to meet our commitments in support and service.

The electronic sign fund has reached a donation point of \$15,000 which is approximately 50% of anticipated cost.

The budget for this year projected a \$20,000 deficit. I am confident that as was the case last year, we will be able to balance the budget by year end. Your continued support of BCUC is greatly appreciated and allows us to make a difference. Ross Mutton, Treasurer
