WHAT IS A REMIT? It is a vote to enable changes to the Basis of Union in the United Church of Canada. We now have a Category 3 Remit which requires a **vote** by every regional council and each pastoral charge's governing body, by **March 31, 2024.**

Our Official Board has been studying the issue and is getting ready to vote. It also wants the congregation to be informed about the issue of **changing the United Church of Canada's three-council structure to include an autonomous National Indigenous Organisation.**

Everything you need to know can be found online by Googling either **GC 44 Remit** or **United Church Remit.** We have created a document with 13 main subjects/questions that clearly explains what this remit is all about and what the Board will soon be voting on. Each of these has been printed on a card and posted in the church hall. For more information talk to Nicole or a member of the Board.

Mitten Tree hats and mittens are being donated to City of Ottawa Carling Family Shelter. Thanks to Bev Graham for making the delivery of all the colourful knitted hats, scarves and mittens that have decorated the little tree outside the office during Advent.

2023 Advent Project: The Advent Project for 2023 is support for the **Mission and Service Fund** of the United Church. It has recently been announced that the grants from the M&S fund to the regions of the church including our local EOORC region will be reduced by 30%. This will significantly affect the ability of EOORC to support some key local programs in our area such as the Ottawa West End Community Chaplaincy, the Carlington Chaplaincy, Centre 507 and three summer camps including the Camp Awesome leadership training program. It is often thought that this Fund is for support of partners overseas, but in 2022, 69% of the funds were spent within Canada. We encourage you to make a flow-through donation to the M&S fund - which will be a donation sent to M&S over and above what the church gives through the budget process. A flow-through donation can be made either by an e-transfer to 'treasurer@bcuc.org' with M&S Fund in the message line, or give a cheque to the office marked for Mission and Service Fund. **As of January 5, the total is \$4,460. Keep the donations coming! The thermometer is set for \$5,000!**
