Let's Learn some Trans-words and Their Usage

Transgender: describes someone whose gender identity doesn't correspond with their sex as assigned at birth. This word is 100% polite.

Transsexual: a transgender person, especially one who has undergone sex reassignment, with or without surgery. This word, with its focus on anatomy and physiology, may be appropriate in a medical context. Otherwise avoid it unless a person identifies themselves as transsexual.

Transvestite: a person who dresses in clothes primarily associated with the "other" sex or gender. This word is outdated and has a negative connotation. A more neutral replacement is "crossdresser" or, if it's done as part of a certain kind of public performance, "drag queen," "drag king," or "drag performer."
